HOLIDOG BEAST FEAST (from Cooking the Three Dog Bakery Way)

1 small apple, diced (about ½ cup)

1 tablespoon canola oil

2 pounds boneless chicken, diced
½ cup unsweetened applesauce

1 teaspoon dried sage

1 cup frozen peas or green beans, thawed and drained
1 cup wild rice or long grain rice

3 cups chicken stock or low-sodium chicken broth
Preheat oven to 350 degrees F

Saute the apples in the oil for 2 minutes, or until tender. Place the apple in the bottom of Dutch oven or similar covered casserole. Add the remaining ingredients, stirring to combine. Cover and bake for 1 hour or until the rice is tender. Cool to room temperature before serving. Store covered in the refrigerator for up to 3 days.
